## Mississippi Postsecondary Education Financial Assistance Board to meet January 13

The Mississippi Postsecondary Education Financial Assistance Board will hold a regular meeting on Wednesday, January 13, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. The Board will review the FY 2020 Annual Report of the State-Supported Student Financial Aid Programs and approve the report for submission to the Mississippi Legislature. Due to recommendations from the Mississippi State Department of Health for social distancing due to the coronavirus, members of the Board may participate in the meeting via video or teleconference. Members of the public and media may attend the meeting in Room 218 of the Education and Research Center, 3825 Ridgewood Road, Jackson, Miss. 39211, allowing the maximum number in the room per the most recent Executive Order issued by Governor Tate Reeves. An Executive Session may be held in accordance with the Open Meetings Act.

The Mississippi Postsecondary Education Financial Assistance Board has authority over all state student financial aid programs, which include undergraduate and graduate grant and forgivable loan programs. Public, private, two-year and four-year college students in Mississippi may be eligible for state aid.

The Director of the Postsecondary Board is appointed by the Mississippi Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, which governs the public universities in Mississippi, including Alcorn State University; Delta State University; Jackson State University; Mississippi State University including the Mississippi State University Division of Agriculture, Forestry and Veterinary Medicine; Mississippi University for Women; Mississippi Valley State University; the University of Mississippi including the University of Mississippi Medical Center; and the University of Southern Mississippi.
