WHAT IS AN EFC?

- Expected Family Contribution (EFC) is a Derived From Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
 - EFC Ranges from 0 to 999,999
 - EFC Range for Pell Grant is From 0 5,846

NEW AWARD MATRIX

- Based on Expected Family Contribution (EFC) Need Based Component
- Based on American College Test (ACT) Academic Based Component

AWARDING MATRIX- WHERE WE ARE

- Student Population
 - All Students Who Completed a 2019-20 State Aid Application
 - Had a GPA of 2.5 or Greater
 - Had an ACT of 15 or Greater
- Created an Extensive Excel Program to Run Multiple Scenarios From the Point of View of:
 - Student Awards
- Building Scenarios that keeps us within the current \$48 million Appropriations Budget
